Cyan Renewables Pte. Ltd. : Scaling Offshore-Wind Services Across APAC and Beyond

Singapore-headquartered Cyan Renewables has rapidly expanded as a pioneer in global offshore wind vessel operations, supporting the world's transition to a greener future. In **July 2024**, it completed the **A\$1.1 billion acquisition of MMA Offshore**, significantly enlarging its fleet and global footprint and positioning Cyan as a leading Asia-Pacific platform in offshore-wind support services.

Cyan supports offshore wind developments globally from concept to installation, anchoring its capabilities in Singapore and supporting the global energy transition safely, efficiently and sustainably. Cyan's collaboration with training providers and technology partners also contributes to workforce capability-building and reinforces Singapore's growing presence in the global offshore-wind supply chain.

Seatrium Limited : Advancing Complex Projects and Lower-Carbon Solutions

A global leader in providing engineering solutions across the offshore, marine, and energy sectors, Seatrium brings over six decades of expertise in the design and construction of complex assets, counting global energy majors amongst its repeat customers.

With a diversified business across oil and gas, renewables, new energies and repairs & upgrades; Seatrium plays a pivotal role in advancing the world's transition from traditional to clean energy; as well as maritime decarbonisation through its projects and innovations. Seatrium is poised to deliver 14GW of offshore wind transmission assets for delivery through 2031 for customers in Europe and Asia; and has completed 49 green retrofits in 2024, which remarkable milestones aligned with the M&OE Industry Plan 2030.

It is also expanding into offshore renewables, including the formation of a joint venture for cable logistics. The company has also invested in SMART vessel technologies and digitalisation, strengthening operational excellence and data-driven decision-making.

Mr Soh has played a key role in supporting ASMI's programmes under the Marine & Offshore Energy Industry Plan 2030, enabling companies to innovate, digitalise and capture emerging opportunities in offshore renewables and advanced manufacturing.
